



SPRING CITY POOL RULES

- No one may enter without paying or presenting their pass. **NO SHARING PASSES**
- No one under the age of 11 may enter without an adult or babysitter age 15 or older.
- All children 10 & under **MUST** pass a swim test in order to swim in the big pool by yourself. If an adult is in the water with you, you may swim in the lower end of the large pool, but are prohibited from using the diving board and swimming in the deep end.
- No street clothes may be worn in the pools.
- There will be allotted time for swimming laps as deemed possible by the Pool Manager. Please keep off lane dividers.
- Use of the wading pool is limited to toddlers and preschool age children, 5 and under. Parents are responsible for their children's safety at all times. A parent or babysitter, 15 years or old **MUST** be **IN** the wading pool with the child.
- Only **small** flotation devices are permitted in the pools (i.e. water wings, small tubes or floats, noodles and soft toys)
- Infants and toddlers must wear a swim diaper. Infants and toddlers with swim diapers are **NOT** permitted in the large pool. Swim diapers are available for purchase at the pool office.
- The lifeguard is responsible for the enforcement of the pool rules and regulations. All instructions given by the lifeguards are to be followed. He/She has the authority to temporarily deprive any guest the use of the facility, with the managers approval a written statement will be filed by the lifeguard with the pool manager and pool office within 24 hours of such action being taken.
- Use of the pool facility without a lifeguard in attendance is strictly forbidden
- Admissions will be refused to all persons who are intoxicated, have open sores or inflamed eyes, nasal or ear discharges, or any communicable disease of any kind. Only a doctor's note will permit otherwise. Persons with excessive sunburn, open sores, or bandage of any kind will not be admitted.
- Spitting, spouting of water, nose blowing, urinating or defecating are not permitted in the pool.
- No glass containers are allowed in the pool area. No food will be consumed on the pool deck or in the immediate vicinity of the pool.
- All trash and refuse must be placed in the receptacles provided.
- No running, boisterous or rough plays, dunking, or snapping of towels in or around the pool area.
- No unnecessary/excessive talking to the lifeguards.
- No smoking on pool property. A smoking receptacle and location is provided outside of the pool gate.
- Possession and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages within the fenced-in pool area, or in the outside park facility and in the parking lot is **STRICTLY FORBIDDEN.**
- You may bring food into the pool, but no food deliveries are allowed inside the gate.
- We reserve the right to inspect all coolers, bags and baskets. No grills, gas or electric may be brought into the pool complex.
- No pets are allowed.
- No cell phones are permitted in the restrooms.
- The pool manager or lifeguard may close any portion of or the entire pool complex for any safety or maintenance reason.
- No vandalism, stealing, lewd behavior or profanity of any kind.
- All persons using the pool's furniture must place a towel over the lounge or chair before sitting/laying down to limit suntan lotions from deteriorating or staining the furniture. If chairs are moved, please return them to their original position when done.
- All emergencies and injuries are to be reported to a lifeguard who will then take charge over the situation. A written statement will be filed with the pool manager and pool office within 24 hours.

IF YOU HAVE A PROBLEM, QUESTION OR CONCERN, PLEASE SEE THE POOL MANAGER.

DIVING BOARD RULES

- Only one person at a time on the diving board.
- Wait until the person in front of you reaches the ladder before you dive off.
- Only one bounce on the board
- Jump off straight, not at an angle.
- No sailor dives, Back dives or dives that the lifeguards deem to be unsafe.
- No throwing anything to the person going off the dive.
- No goggles, masks or floating devices may be worn when going off the diving board.

THE MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO EJECT ANYONE FOR DISORDERLY BEHAVIOR OR NOT FOLLOWING POOL RULES. FUTURE ADMISSION MAY ALSO BE DENIED AT MANAGEMENT'S DISCRETION.
